



### Franklin B. Brown

Frank Brown joined the teaching faculty at TCC in 1989. He taught for eleven years and served as program chair. Frank assumed the role of Dean of Science and Math in 2000 where he remained until 2013. As Dean under Frank's leadership the division grew and prospered. Dozens of new faculty members were hired, and a major overhaul of the biology and chemistry labs was realized. Colleagues say that as a Dean Frank led with integrity, wisdom and compassion.

Outside of TCC Frank was an active member of Saint Paul's United Methodists Church, serving on various committees, and teaching Sunday school class with his typical dedication and great sense of humor. He was also a member of the Tallahassee Scientific Society.

Five years ago, at his own request Frank returned to the TCC classroom and to his true passion of teaching students chemistry. Throughout his tenure Frank served as a mentor, colleague, friend and an inspiration to the students he taught. Frank passed away in July, 2018.

Frank is remember by his colleague Sheri Rowland in this way: "TCC has lost one of its finest. His legacy will go on for many generations through all of us who knew him, especially his students. I can think of no better person to be inducted into the TCC Hall of Fame."
