SUBJECT: Academic Program and Course Changes for 2012-2013

Item Description

This item presents the proposed changes in curriculum for the next academic year.

Overview and Background

As part of the annual program review, each division revises course offerings and adds or deletes programs to assure currency and relevancy. The Academic Planning Committee Curriculum members review and make recommendations for Board approval. Recommendations align with state policy, SACS accreditation standards, and the College mission. The Committee presents the Board with the attached recommendations. The Board has the responsibility for approval and discontinuance of courses and programs in accordance with Florida state law.

Past Actions by the Board

The Board approves curriculum changes annually.

Funding/Financial Implications

A new position will be requested in the 2012-13 fiscal year to coordinate the Welding Technologies Program, if approved. Salary range will be \$41,000-\$47,000. All other curriculum changes require no new funding.

NEW PROGRAMS

Welding Technologies Postsecondary Adult Vocational Certificate (1,170 clock hours)

 According to the 2011-2012 Targeted Occupation List for Gadsden, Leon, and Wakulla Counties, welders will have a total positive growth of 3.08%. Several employers have provided letters of support. The welding occupation is also on the Florida Statewide 2012-2013 Demand Occupation List.

Engineering Technology Support Specialist Certificate (18 credit hours)

 According to the 2011-2012 Targeted Occupation List for Gadsden, Leon, and Wakulla Counties, Engineering Technologists will have positive growth.
 Occupations such as Industrial Machinery Mechanics have a 2.65% positive growth and First-Line Supervisor of Mechanics have a 1.56% positive growth.

Fire Sprinkler Design Technology Certificate (18 credit hours)

According to Occupational outlook Handbook for 2011-2012, there is a 9% positive growth nationwide. Fire Sprinkler Designers also work as Fire Inspectors and Fire Investigators.

Medical Coding and Billing Specialist Certificate (34 credit hours)

According to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity, the state of
Florida is projected to have an annual job growth increase of 2%. State law
mandates the use of electronic medical records so there is an increasing demand
for certified coding specialists.

Health Information Technology Associate in Science Degree (70 credit hours)

 According to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity, Health Information Technologists is projected to have a 2.13% positive growth in the state of Florida. Health Information Technologists is on the 2012-2013 Target Occupation List for Gadsden, Leon, and Wakulla Counties.

COURSE CHANGES

Based on the program changes above and on review of curriculum content and assessment, the following changes are recommended.

- Reclassify BSC 2085, Anatomy and Physiology I, as a General Education Science course.
- Change HIM 1000, Introduction to Health Information, from 2 to 3 credit hours because coverage of both Health Informatics and Health Information Management can be better accomplished in a single course.
- Change HIM 2012, Legal Aspects of Healthcare, from 2 to 3 credit hours because this
 course needs more time added to provide adequate coverage of the material.
- Change HIM 2304, Healthcare Informatics Project Management, to HIM 2512 because HIM 2512 will represent a revision of the course to better reflect AHIMA competencies and DOE objectives.
- Change HIM 2112, Health Information Technology, to HIM 2112C which will allow for lab hours needed for the material.
- Change HIM 1433, Pathophysiology, to HIM 2433. This is an increase in credit hours from 3 to 4 as well as course number change to better reflect the level of material covered in the course and to provide more time to cover this subject in depth.
- Change PMT 2254C, Computer Numerical Control II, from 4 credit hours to 3 credit hours.
- Change ETM 2315C, Hydraulics and Pneumatics, from 4 to 3 credit hours.
- BCN 2230 Construction Materials and Methods Remove prerequisite and corequisite (EGS 1111C)
 - The course redesign has eliminated the need for EGS 1111C.
- BCN 2272 Plans Interpretation Remove prerequisite (EGS 2112C) and corequisite (ETD 2340)
 - The course redesign has eliminated the need for EGS 2111C and ETD 2340.
- BCN 2704 Construction Contracts, Code and Laws Remove the computer proficiency prerequisite
 - The course does not involve direct computer applications.
- BCT 2705 Construction Management Remove the computer proficiency prerequisite
 - The course does not involve direct computer applications.
- BCT 2770 Construction Estimating and Concepts Remove prerequisite (MAC 1105) and corequisite (MAC 2114); Add new prerequisite (BCT 1001)
 - The applied math, BCT 1001, is needed for building construction, drafting and design.
- SUR 2100C Fundamentals of Land Surveying Remove prerequisites (MAC 1105) and (MAC 2114); Add new prerequisite (BCT 1001)
 - The applied math, BCT 1001, is needed for building construction, drafting and design.
- SUR 2390 GIS Application in Engineering and Technology Remove the computer proficiency prerequisite

- This course does not involve direct computer applications
- CAP 2023 Introduction to Game Programming Add prerequisite (COP 2220)
 - COP 2220 covers programming basics and COP 2023 is the introductory course for computer game design.
- CAP 2024 Advanced Game programming Remove prerequisite (CGS 2525)
 - Additional course preparation will take place in COP 2220.
- PLA 2114 Legal Writing Remove prerequisite (PLA 1104)
 - The way in which we have been teaching these courses has allowed students to take either class first in the series because these classes reinforce legal skills and knowledge but do not depend on the legal skills and knowledge from either class.
