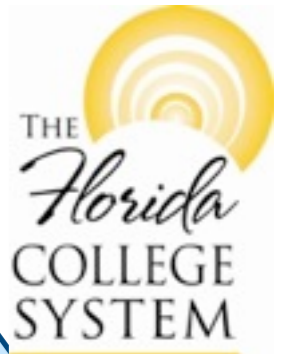





In the future, what is a college and why should students attend?




In the future, who will our students be and what do we need to do to educate and prepare them?




What is the “interesting future” for the College? For our community?


