Dental Programs

- Enrollment (Fall 2016)
 - ▶ Hygiene (Year 1): 25
 - ▶ Hygiene (Year 2): 20
 - ▶ Assisting: 9
- Licensure Exam Pass Rates
 - ▶ Hygiene (National): 94%
 - ▶ Hygiene (State): 85%
 - ▶ Assisting: 4 out of 15 took the exam
- Job Placement Rates
 - ▶ Hygiene: 82%
 - ▶ Assisting: 73%
- Supervising Dentists
 - ▶ Lisa Hofstad, DMD
 - ▶ Wanda Goodreau, DMD

Emergency Medical Services

- EMT Licensure Exam Pass Rates (2016)
 - ▶ First attempt: 91%
 - ▶ Overall: 96%
- Paramedic Licensure Exam Pass Rates (2016)
 - ▶ First attempt: 85%
 - ▶ Overall: 85%
- Job Placement Rate
 - ▶ Three-year: 92%

Health Information Technology

- Currently offering four classes
- Updating clinical site Affiliation Agreements
- Anticipating 15 new students for fall semester
- Currently in Candidacy Status with the Commission on Accreditation for Health Informatics and Information Management (CAHIIM)
- Updating course content to include the new CAHIIM standards that must be in place by August

Nursing

- Enrollment (Spring 2017)
 - ▶ AS: 194
 - ▶ RN-BSN: 42
- 51 graduating in May (AS)
- Licensure Exam Pass Rate (2016)
 - ▶ NCLEX: 96%
 - ▶ Florida Average: 73%
 - ▶ US Average: 85%
- Job Placement
 - ▶ AS: 100%
- 42 students currently enrolled in RN-BSN
- Most enrolled in 1-2 classes per semester
- Currently eligible to apply to become candidates for accreditation

Pharmacy Management

- Enrollment remains a challenge
- First Pharmacy Management AS class scheduled to complete in Spring 2017
- Currently seeking adjunct instructors

Radiology Technology

- Enrollment
 - ▶ 2016 Cohort: 14
 - ▶ 2017 Cohort: 12
 - ▶ 2018 Accepted: 28
- Licensure Exam Pass Rates
 - ▶ 2015 Cohort: 100%
 - ▶ 2016 Cohort: 100%
 - ▶ National Average: 80%
- Job Placement Rates
 - ▶ 2015 Cohort: 79%
 - ▶ 2016 Cohort: 48%

Respiratory Care

- Enrollment
 - ▶ Fall 2015: 14
 - ▶ Fall 2016: 14
 - ▶ 2018 Accepted: 28
- Job Placement Rates
 - ▶ 2016 Cohort: 100%
 - ▶ Three-year: 94%
- Licensure Exam Pass Rates
 - ▶ CRT (2016): 75%
 - ▶ CRT (3 Year): 100%
 - ▶ RRT (2016): 88%
 - ▶ RRT (3 Year): 88%

CRT = Certified Respiratory Therapist (First level certification)

RRT = Registered Respiratory Therapist (Second level certification which requires an Associate's degree)

Surgical Technology

- Enrollment
 - ▶ First Semester: 9
 - ▶ Second Semester: 4
 - ▶ Fourth Semester: 5
 - Licensure Exam Pass Rates
 - ▶ CST (Spring 2016): 70%
 - ▶ CST (Fall 2016): 100%
 - Job Placement Rate
 - ▶ 2016: 94%
- CST = Certified Surgical Technologies

Central Sterile Processing

- Licensure Exam Pass Rate
 - ▶ 2016: 100%
- Faculty shortage in area

Endoscopy Technician

- Licensure Exam Pass Rate
 - ▶ 2016: 100%
- Job Placement Rates (2016)
 - ▶ Full-time: 1
 - ▶ Part-time: 2
 - ▶ Continuing education: 3
