Programs in Review

Nursing (ASN)

- Spring 2018 increased enrollment from 48 to 56 students
- NCLEX pass rate 99.07%



RN-to-BSN



- 80 students currently enrolled
- First graduates in fall 2018 (7)
- 5 candidates for spring 2019 graduation

Dental

- 23 Dental Hygiene Graduates
 - 83% (19/23) passed certification exam
 - 87% (20/23) passed national boards
- 14 Dental Assisting Graduates
 - 1 took exam and passed



EMT/Paramedic



- 19 Paramedic graduates
 - 100% certification exam pass rate
- 86 EMS graduates
 - 96.5% (83/86) certification exam pass rate



Radiology Technology

- 25 graduates
- Certification exam pass rate is 100%
- Evelyn Valentin and 4 students attended the Association of Radiologic Technologist Conference in Atlanta



Respiratory Therapy



- 14 graduates
- CRT certification exam pass rate 84.6% (11/13)
- RRT certification exam pass rate 100% 10/10



Surgical Services

- 18 graduates
- Certification exam pass rate 94% (17/18)
