

Ballistic Shield Instructor Region XV

Course Description:

This two-day course will expose students to best practices when using a ballistic shield and how to develop a ballistic shield training program for in-service training. Topics to be covered include NIJ ballistic ratings; shield materials and types; weapon transitions and offhand shooting with a shield; shooting on the move with a shield in single and double operator applications; downed officer rescue; and vehicle takedowns.

Required Equipment:

- 500 rounds of pistol ammo and 200 rounds of rifle ammo
- 3 pistol and 3 rifle mags, eye and ear protection
- Ballistic vest or hard armor carrier
- SIMM/UTM pistol and 100 rounds of ammo
- Agency shield if you have one

Pistol and rifle ammo will be provided for Region 15 officers if needed. We will not provide SIMM ammo
