

CJSTC Firearms Instructor Region XV

Course Description:

This 44-hour course is requisite for CJSTC certification as Firearms Instructor. This course will prepare an instructor-student to obtain Commission certification as a High Liability Instructor in Firearms and instruct the Criminal Justice Firearms Course in the Florida Basic Recruit Training Program: High Liability. Topics include legal issues, range management, basic shooting principles, shooting deficiency, equipment familiarization, survival considerations, and practical exercises. Participants must qualify by the shooting standards of the basic police academy.

***Ammo will be provided for Region XV officers. All others must bring 500 rounds of appropriate handgun ammo. If you have a Red Dot Sight it must be able to be removed during the class. ***.
