What you need to ID sheet – Bones of the Arm and Forearm

This sheet tells you what you need to be able to identify on these bones – check the “to know” sheet for anything else you may need to know about this topic.

You are **done** with these bones when you can identify **all** of the following:

L/R Humerus

- capitulum
- coronoid fossa
- head
- lateral epicondyle
- medial epicondyle
- olecranon fossa
- radial fossa
- trochlea

L/R Ulna

- coronoid process
- olecranon (olecranon process)
- radial notch
- trochlear (semilunar) notch
- styloid process

L/R Radius

- radial head
- radial tuberosity
- styloid process
- ulnar notch
